Saturday, December 6th Sunwatch Indian Village

Pack 489 is going to Sunwatch Indian Village, an archaeologically reconstructed Ft. Ancient Peoples' Village from the 13th century. The overnight program runs from 6:00 pm - 8:00 am and will include a full program of activities, crafts, tours, an evening snack, and light breakfast. Cost is \$15 per person. Scouts will sleep in the Interpretive Center.



Boonshoft Museum is also close by. If you want to make a full day of it, explore Boonshoft's live animal zoo, Planetarium, interactive science and technology exhibits, dozens of family-friendly permanent exhibits, as well as special featured traveling exhibitions. Admission is \$8.50 adults, \$7 children under 12, or *free* if you have a Cincinnati Museum Center membership.
